


Good Shepherd Stand-up Figures for Lesson Time


What You Need

- Printer and (or) copier
- Scissors
- Five empty cardboard bath tissue rolls (if using images in current size and not enlarging)
- Glue stick or tape
- I. If you have not made these figures for prior lessons, print the shepherd, sheep, thom bush and wolf patterns. Copy or print the page with sheep twice, so you have a total of six sheep.
- 2. Cut out all the patterns. Hold the shepherd upright and glue him around a bath tissue roll so he can stand.


- 3. Cut the four remaining bath tissue rolls in half. Glue each sheep, the thorn bush and the wolf around a half-roll.
- 4. To increase visibility, especially if you have a large group, enlarge the images and print on ledger (11×17) size paper. To make the images stand, round the sides of each image to make a cylinder shape and secure the back of the cylinder with tape or glue.







Either print on paper, cut and attach to craft, or print on Avery labels 48863, template 5163 and use as stickers. Cut stickers to create individual images.
